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## **DELAWARE'S ONE-TIME TAX AMNESTY PROGRAM CLOSES TOMORROW LAST DAY TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF UNIQUE TAX PROGRAM**

Statewide, DE – October 29, 2009 – Division of Revenue Director Patrick T. Carter announced today that Delaware's 2009 Voluntary Tax Compliance Initiative (VTCI) will come to a close at midnight tomorrow, October 30, 2009. With only one day left to take advantage of this one-time tax amnesty offer, Delaware encourages all remaining eligible individuals and businesses to register for the program as quickly as possible.

"After tomorrow, all tax liabilities not registered with VTCI will include penalty and interest fees," says Carter. "If you're a business or individual with an outstanding tax balance, you really should take advantage of this program. By registering you can save yourself a great deal of money."

VTCI is a one-time tax amnesty program designed for individuals and businesses to pay their outstanding State of Delaware tax liabilities, free of penalty and interest. Through October 30th, 2009, any individual or business taxpayer who registers to pay their current outstanding State of Delaware tax liability administered by the Division of Revenue will have their penalty and interest fees waived. All balances must then be paid in full by June 30, 2010.

To take advantage of VTCI, taxpayers must call 877-551-5233 before midnight on Friday, October 30<sup>th</sup>. The hotline will then close until November 2, 2009, at which point those already registered with VTCI can call regarding their payment plans.
