Delaware Update to Hurricane Irene and Tropical Storm Lee Filing Relief for All Delaware Taxpayers

DELAWARE – The Delaware Division of Revenue has announced today that it will extend the filing deadline for all Delaware individual and business taxpayers that previously obtained a 2011 tax-filing extension.

Delaware's tax-filing extension applies to all individuals and businesses extending their 2011 State of Delaware Partnership, Corporate, or Individual income taxes, regardless of whether or not the individual or business resides in an IRS-designated Hurricane Irene or Tropical Storm Lee Disaster Area.

The new State of Delaware tax-filing extensions are due as follows:

Tax Type	Previous Extension Due Date	Current Due Date
Partnership	September 15, 2011	October 31, 2011
Corporate	October 3, 2011	October 31, 2011
Individual	October 17, 2011	October 31, 2011

The Delaware Division of Revenue will not assess any late-filing penalties that would otherwise apply to these taxes.
